

Announcement regarding cash dividends for the period before 1 March 2015 which are not collected by the shareholders of Emirates Integrated Telecommunications Company PJSC (the "Company") and which are held with the Company.

Referring to the directives issued by the Securities and Commodities Authority regarding cash dividends for the period before 1 March 2015, which are not collected by the shareholders of local listed public shareholding companies and held with companies.

In case the concerned shareholder is entitled to any cash dividends, they are required to provide the Company (or the Company's Registrar) with the following documents to claim the cash dividends:

- A letter signed by the shareholder or their legal representative addressed to the Company that includes a request to issue a cheque or make a bank transfer for, the amount of cash dividend due.
- The original Emirates ID of the shareholder and a copy of it or the original passport of the shareholder and a copy of it.
- 3. In the case of a public or private power of attorney for the shareholder, please provide the original and authenticated power of attorney document with a copy of it, as well as the Emirates ID of the agent and a copy of it or the original passport of the agent and a copy of it.
- 4. Any other documents required by the Company.

We would like to confirm that starting from **14 February 2021**, all unclaimed cash dividends for the period before 1 March 2015 that have not been claimed by the beneficiaries will be transferred to the Securities and Commodities Authority, who will be responsible for disbursing these unclaimed dividends to the shareholders when claimed, and the Authority will publish a statement on their website and the website of the financial market explaining the full details in due course.
